

## Approval of Schedule and Results

---

Dear NF Members,

Please find herewith a copy of the approved Schedule for your upcoming event; a copy of it must be forwarded to the Organising Committee upon receipt.  
A copy must also be sent to all acting officials and invited NFs.

In accordance with Article 110.1 and 110.2 of the FEI GRs, alterations to the Definite Schedule must be submitted to the FEI for approval and be notified to all invited NFs. No changes may be made to the Approved Schedule within two weeks prior to the start of the event.

Furthermore, we look forward to receiving within two days after the event(s) (Art. 109.6 FEI GRs):

- the detailed results of each of the international competitions (in percentage with 3 decimals), with the prize money distributed to each place and rider in each competition, awarded on the basis of one prize for every four starters with a minimum of five prizes, complete with rider ID numbers and horse ID numbers.
- Dressage results have to be submitted in the FEI Official Results Form:

As of the 1st January 2017, it will be compulsory to submit all Dressage competition results with detailed scores broken down figure by figure and Judge by Judge.

It will be possible to upload these detailed results in a XML format directly to the FEI Database or manually enter these results on a specially designed online dressage results interface.

We strongly encourage the use of XML results and we are pleased to provide you with the XSD documentation and XML examples to help put this new process in place.

OCs that do not submit their results with prize money distributed, rider ID numbers and horse passport numbers on time (or incomplete results / prize money distributed) to the FEI will be invoiced CHF 1'000.- in addition to the amount for organizing dues (Art. 109.6 FEI GRs).
